Wear neutral, earth-toned clothes (khaki, green, brown). Bright colors can scare animals; dark colors attract tsetse flies.

- **Be Patient:**

The wild is unpredictable – the most magical sightings often reward those who wait quietly and observe closely.

- **Carry Cash for Tips:**

Tipping your guide and lodge staff is customary. USD or Tanzanian Shillings are accepted.

- **Support Local Communities:**

Buy local crafts, visit cultural villages, and engage respectfully with local people — your visit makes a difference.

- **Don't Make Loud Noises or Sudden Movements:**
